EDUCATION AND TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES 2009-10

This brochure details the range of predominately part-time education opportunities available (although some of our full-time courses are included), and is aimed at anyone involved with service users within health or social care settings. It is a useful tool for choosing the right course for you. You can opt to study short awards such as a University Certificate or a degree at honours, master's or doctorate level.

The model of provision used within these educational opportunities reflects the themes identified in current, local and national initiatives in health and social care practice, including High Quality Care for All (2008), long-term conditions, service improvement, commissioning and end of life care.

The courses in this brochure are categorised within specialist areas as guidance. Please note that many aspects of the courses available are suitable for integrated roles undertaken by employees in health and social care.

Details of the full-time/eligibility for licence to practice programmes offered by the School of Health & Social Care are not included in this brochure but can be found in the University prospectus or on our website.



University Certificate in Continuing Education (UCCE)

A UCCE award comprises 20 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and is normally made up of one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Postgraduate Continuing Education (UCPCE)

A UCPCE award comprises 20 credits at master's level and is normally made up of one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Professional Development (UCPD)

A UCPD normally comprises at least 30 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and may be made up of more than one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Advanced Professional Development (UCAPD)

A UCAPD normally comprises at least 60 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and may be made up of more than one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Postgraduate Professional Development (UCPPD)

A UCPPD award comprises at least 30 master's level credits and may be made up of more than one academic module of learning.

National Vocational Qualification (NVQ)

NVQs are nationally-recognised qualifications, awarded for competent performance in work-based activities. They reflect the skills and knowledge needed to do a job effectively, and indicate that a candidate is competent in the National Occupational Standards for the area the NVQ represents.



Certificate in Higher Education (Cert HE), Foundation Degree (FD)

These are higher education awards which involve predominantly work-based learning. They are designed in conjunction with employers to equip their staff with the knowledge and skills they have identified. Opportunities are available for progression on to a programme leading to an honours degree.

Undergraduate and Postgraduate Studies

The School offers a comprehensive range of honours degrees, postgraduate certificates, master's degrees and doctorates.

Externally Delivered

A number of awards are delivered externally and accredited by the University of Teesside. Please see the relevant School contact.

Funding

Most awards are free of charge to non-medical staff of NHS/Primary Care Trusts, hospices and prison services throughout the North East Strategic Health Authority. You must check with Admissions whether the education is free or fee paying before enrolling.

There are also a limited number of places available on some of our courses/awards FREE of charge to staff from social services and independent, voluntary and charitable organisations. Individuals are advised to confirm this information prior to applying by contacting Admissions.

For those applicants who do not fall into any of the above categories standard University fees will apply. You may, however, be eligible for a University of Teesside scholarship or bursary. Further details can be found on our website at www.tees.ac.uk.

APL/APEL

If you have undertaken previous study or have significant experience within your field of practice you may be eligible for Accreditation of Prior Learning/Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APL/APEL) which formally recognises this and gives you advanced standing towards an award of the University.
