Prospective Student Report Form

It is the function of this course is to produce qualified diagnostic radiographers at a level suitable to work in the NHS and private sector. As such, we are looking for people who have a **broad** understanding of the varied roles open to radiographers, both in and out of the NHS.

Traditionally this was achieved by obtaining work experience shadowing a diagnostic radiographer. However, due to the increased demand for places on diagnostic radiography courses there has been an equal increase in demand for placements within diagnostic radiography departments to the extent that they are now difficult to obtain. We do not therefore, **insist** on actual experience though we **strongly recommend** you make every effort available to gain this. You will find attached a prospective student report form which we encourage you to take to your clinical placement for them to complete and pass on to us. This will then be used as evidence of your placement during the selection process.

Any work experience with a radiographer is advantageous, and an outline of all efforts made to achieve this would demonstrate your determination. If you have been unable to gain access to a radiographer, any work experience gained within the health and social care setting would strengthen your application.

When describing your experience, it is not enough to merely list the areas in which radiographers work. You should explain, in depth, what you learned from the experience, what skills you feel a radiographer needs and how your personal attributes equip you for this type of work.
