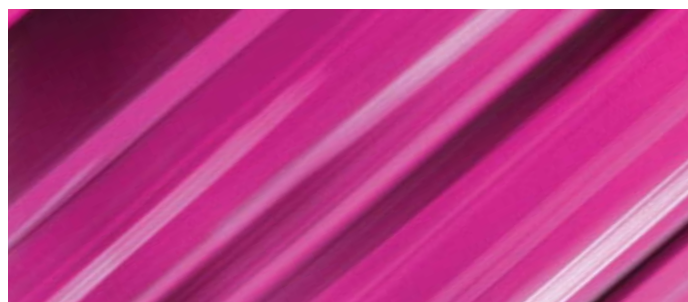

You can opt to study short awards such as a University Certificate, or a degree at honours, master's or doctorate level.

Our courses reflect the themes identified in current local and national initiatives in health and social care practice including, High Quality Care for All (2008), long-term conditions, service improvement, commissioning and end-of-life care.

These courses are categorised within specialist areas to guide you. Many aspects are suitable for integrated health and social care roles.

University Certificate (UC)

A UC award comprises 10 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and is normally made up of one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Continuing Education (UCCE)

A UCCE award comprises 20 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and is normally made up of one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Postgraduate Continuing Education (UCPCE)

A UCPCE award comprises 20 credits at master's level and is normally made up of one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Professional Development (UCPD)

A UCPD normally comprises at least 30 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and may be made up of more than one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Advanced Professional Development (UCAPD)

A UCAPD normally comprises at least 60 credits at certificate, diploma or degree level and may be made up of more than one academic module of learning.

University Certificate in Postgraduate Professional Development (UCPPD)

A UCPPD award comprises at least 30 master's level credits and may be made up of more than one academic module of learning.

National Vocational Qualification (NVQ)

NVQs are nationally-recognised qualifications, awarded for competent performance in work-based activities. They reflect the skills and knowledge needed to do a job effectively, and indicate that a candidate is competent in the National Occupational Standards for the area the NVQ represents.

Certificate of Higher Education (CertHE), Foundation Degree (FD)

These are higher education awards which mainly involve work-based learning. They are designed with employers to equip their staff with the knowledge and skills they have

identified. You have the opportunity to progress on to a programme leading to an honours degree.

Undergraduate and postgraduate studies

We offer a comprehensive range of honours degrees, postgraduate certificates, master's degrees and doctorates.

Off-campus delivery

A number of our courses are delivered off campus in venues throughout the north east. Please see relevant School contact listed for more information.

Externally-delivered and collaborative courses

We accredit a number of courses delivered by a range of partner organisations locally and nationally. Our academic staff collaborate with external partners to incorporate quality assurance mechanisms – we ensure our standards meet higher education and the Quality Assurance Agency requirements. Any credits you gain on these courses can be transferred against courses at Teesside University or other higher education institutions.

Funding

We have a contract with the NHS to deliver a portfolio of continuing professional development activity. This is free non-medical NHS employees and hospice staff within the North East Strategic Health Authority. You must check with your manager or our admissions department if the course you are applying for is covered within our contract. If you reserve a place on one of our courses and don't attend without formally cancelling, your employer will be invoiced for the relevant fee.

We may have a limited number of free places available on some of our courses for staff from social services, independent, voluntary and charitable bodies – particularly if your organisation provides practice placements for our students on full-time pre-registration health and social care programmes. For any other applicants standard University fees will apply. Although you may be eligible for alternative support or a Teesside University bursary.

If you have done any previous study or have significant experience within your field of practice you may be eligible for Accreditation of Prior Learning/Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APL/APEL). It formally recognises this and gives you advanced standing towards a University award.

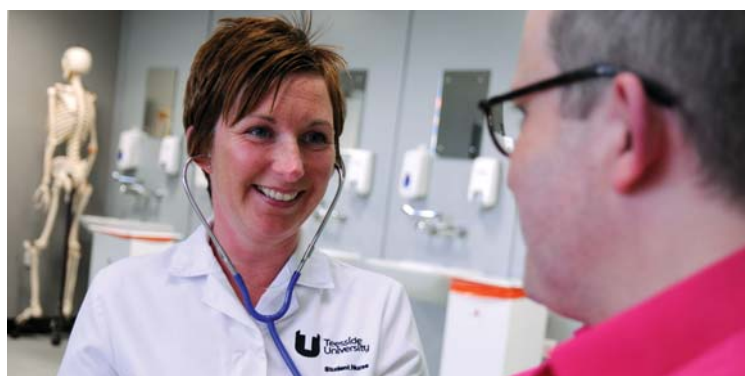
