

A reliability study of a skin sensation test on the sole of the foot in people with Multiple Sclerosis

Aim of study

To investigate the ability of a simple skin sensation test to consistently measure sensation on the sole of the foot in people with Multiple Sclerosis (MS).

What would be associated with a participation in this study?

You would be required to attend two sessions. These could be held at Teesside University, at your local MS group or alternatively in your own home. The first session would last approximately 85 minutes and the second approximately 60 minutes. The sessions would be held between 2 and 10 days apart. During both sessions, you would have your skin sensation measured on the sole of your foot.
