Is the course accredited by a professional body?

What kind of support is available from the library and student services to help with study skills?

Are there opportunities for work placements?

Does the university provide accommodation for all first-year students?

How much is the accommodation?

How far away is the accommodation from the university campus?

How much are the fees?

What scholarships and bursaries do you offer?

What are the entry requirements for the course?

Are students interviewed for the course?

What are the transport links like around the town/city?

What clubs and societies are offered at the Students' Union?

Are there opportunities to study abroad?

What is the nightlife like?
