



Exporting records from Cochrane Library to RefWorks.

Then click on the **'Export selected citations'** link.





Whenever you import any file or text into RefWorks you need to specify the **Import Filter** and then the **Database**.

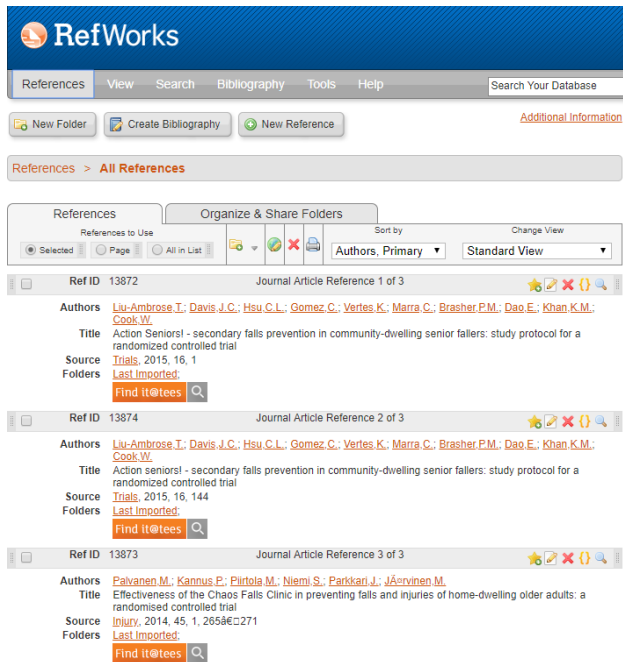

1. Make sure the **From Text File** section is open.
2. Select **RIS Format** as the Import Filter.
3. Then select **RIS Format** as the Database.
4. **Browse** for the file you have just saved and open it. The file name should appear in this box.
5. Click on **Import**

Your file will then be imported into your RefWorks account. Click on **View Last Imported Folder** to see them.

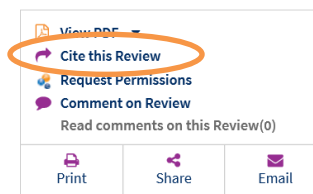


You may notice that some details may not be in the correct format. For the references to be displayed accurately in a bibliography you will need to edit them.

Systematic Reviews

To add a reference for a Cochrane systematic review to your RefWorks account follow the instructions above. However for the reference to be in an accurate format in your bibliography you will need to copy the reference from the Cochrane library as shown below, save it and paste it into your bibliography when you create it.

Click on the **Cite this Review** link from the full text of the review:



Then copy and paste the reference that appears directly under '**Cite this Review**':
