6. Click on the + sign for the main toolbar
7. Then on **Import References**

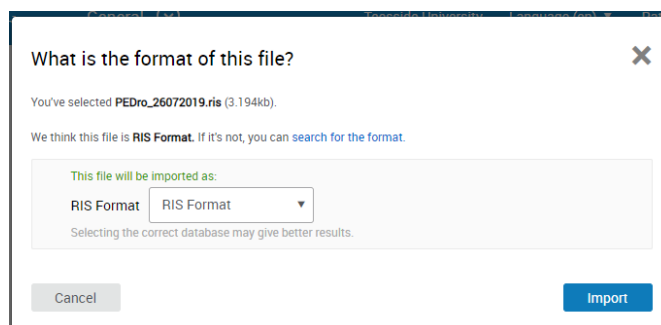


8. From the Import from a file section **select a file from your computer**
9. Locate the file you have just saved / downloaded.

10. The system will recognise this as a RIS file .

11. Select **RIS Format** from the pull-down menu.

12. Then on Import
