IN accordance with section 124A(3) of the Education Reform Act 1988^(a) ("the Act"), the Privy Council by Order dated 26th April 1993 made an instrument of government for The University of Teesside, being a higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect.

SECTION 124A(3)(b) of the Act provides that the Privy Council may by Order modify an instrument of government of any such higher education corporation.

IN accordance with the instrument of government, the Corporation have changed their name with the consent of the Privy Council.

ACCORDINGLY, Their Lordships, in exercise of the powers conferred on Them by section 124A(3)(b), are pleased to modify the instrument of government in accordance with the provision set out in the Schedule to this Order.

MODIFICATIONS TO THE INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT
