Self-declaration of good character

Requirements for evidence of conduct and competence

Programme: Return to Practice - Nursing
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Bodies responsible for Professional Registration such as the NMC require that for entry to and continued participation in a programme leading to professional registration there be processes in place to monitor issues concerning conduct and competence. These issues, which relate to the relevant professional Code of Conduct along with your academic performance, will be considered alongside your application.

It is therefore a requirement for you to complete the following questions and statements, by entering YES or NO.

Should you answer **YES** to questions 1-3 then you may be required to provide additional supporting information.

It will be regarded as Misconduct, for anyone knowingly to make a false declaration or, when required, to fail to complete the declaration.

Good character relates to fitness leading towards registration with the relevant Professional body, not fitness for a particular role.

Students who subsequently discover that a declaration made in good faith was in fact false should inform admissions immediately.
