The following must be submitted with your application for it to be considered. • Are you a previous NMC registered first level nurse (Adult, Child, Mental Health, Learning Disability). You will be asked for your original pin number to verify this with your application, including the date you left the register as you did not revalidate. • Do you have your original award certificate from the institution where you completed your nursing studies (If not, you must contact the provider to ask for a certified copy to submit with your application) • Can you provide two references? One commenting on your nursing career. The second may be a character reference not related to your previous nursing career. • Do you have original certificates from further studies (e.g., BSc/MSc/MA/Specialty courses related to practice). The following is key to considering your application. • Are you free to work a minimum of 15 hours a week in clinical practice that may include nights/weekends depending on your placement allocation. • Are you free to attend the block induction week that includes mandatory training (not optional), also Tuesday evening face-to-face teaching sessions at Darlington Campus 6-9. • Do you anticipate your enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) to be returned with no convictions? (if not, please contact the course lead (details on the home webpage)) • If accepted, you will undertake an Occupational Health assessment. If you have ongoing health issues that may require reasonable adjustments and wish to discuss. Please contact the course lead (details on the home webpage)
